
Take grandma and grandpa for a nature walk

Activity 1:

How To Make A Rainbow




How Are Rainbows Formed?

Sunlight or white light is a mixture of all the rainbow colors. The different rainbow colors are essentially mixed together to result in a white color.

When light passes from one medium to another medium of a different density (e.g. from air to water), the light bends. This is known as <u>refraction of light</u>

White light is split up after passing from air to water and the individual colors become visible. This <u>dispersion of light</u> allows us to see the spectrum of colors that form a rainbow.



Steps to form a Rainbow:

- Fill the glass almost to the top with water.
- If you are using **sunlight**, place the glass so that it is half on and half off the edge of a table, and so that the **sun** shines directly through the **water**, onto a sheet of white paper on the floor.
- Try different angles, adjust the paper and the glass until a **rainbow** forms on the paper.
- Click pictures while doing this activity and present it in a form of a PPT.

Have you ever seen a Rainbow forming a full circle known as "Brahma Dhanush"?

Activity 2:

After understanding the formation of rainbow, imagine there is a rainbow in the sky and write a poem/paragraph describing your feeling on seeing the Rainbow and admiring its beauty.
