Twinkly, winkly stars! I wonder why?

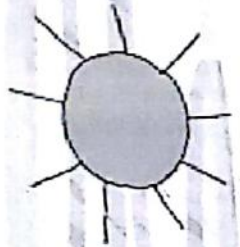


T for turtle that lives in a shell,

Z for zoo, where the zebras neigh

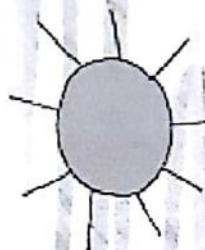

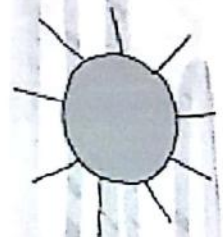


Birthday Cake Colouring Page



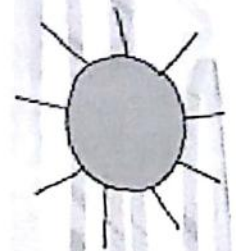
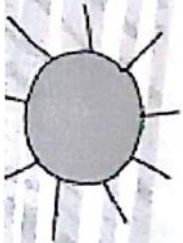
